We hope you and your loved ones are safe as the COVID-19 situation unfolds. Here at the Orlando Cat Cafe, as always, the safety of our guests and felines remains our first priority. We want to assure you, that we have been following the guidelines from the CDC (Center for Disease Control), the WHO (World Health Organization), and local officials.

Governor Ron DeSantis has just announced the mandatory closure of all restaurants in the State of Florida allowing them to be open only for pickup and delivery. Therefore, it is with a heavy heart that we must announce the immediate closure of the Cat Play Area until further notice.

If you have a reservation, it will of course be cancelled with no charge. All Special Events such as Yoga, Painting and Palettes and Trivia are also cancelled until further notice.

Our café partner, Axum Coffee, will remain open for Grab and Go purchases with no in-store dining. Please be assured that they have implemented enhanced safety measures and their staff will be practicing increased hand washing, ongoing sanitation of all surfaces, minimal physical contact, and staying home if they feel unwell.

For the safety of our community, we ask anyone who has potentially come into contact with the virus or is showing any symptoms to please refrain from coming into the café for pick up.
